

Dodford Children's Holiday Farm



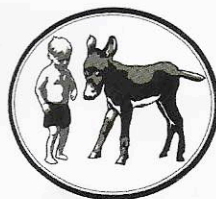
Charity Providing Residential & Day Visits For Schools

We are a long established registered charity offering residential stays to children up to the age of 9. We also offer day visits where we have availability. Most of our visitors are from inner city schools, nurseries and special schools but we can offer a stay to other groups too.

We have 22 beds in the farmhouse over 3 rooms, plus a small flat within the building. Children feed our animals, have a donkey ride, collect eggs, walk in the countryside, play outside, in our pool or in the playbarn or playroom on wet days.

Home cooked meals are included in our very low costs and lengths of stay are flexible.

Family Referrals

Any professional who works with families can refer people for a holiday. This could be a health visitor, doctor, teacher or social worker. Families can come for a low cost break for 5 days where all meals are provided.

Children should be up to 9 years old and stay with a parent or guardian. Families are often referred due to financial hardship, domestic violence, disability or health problems.
